



Unifesp Call N. 07/2019 for Young Talents with experience abroad
UNIFESP INSTITUCIONAL INTERNATIONALIZATION PROJECT (IIP- Unifesp)
CAPES-PRINT PROGRAM

The Rectorate for Graduate Studies and Research of the Universidade Federal de São Paulo (Unifesp) makes public the call for selection of **Young Talents with experience abroad** in the framework of the [Unifesp's Institutional Internationalization Project \(IIP- Unifesp\)](#), approved in [Capes Call N.41/2017](#) - Capes-Print Program. This call is for activities to begin until June 30th, 2019.

I. Objectives of the Capes-Print Program

1. To promote the construction, implementation and consolidation of the strategic plans for internationalization of the institutions contemplated in priority areas knowledge;
2. To stimulate the formation of networks of international researchers aiming at improving the quality of the academic production linked to graduate studies;
3. To expand actions to support the internationalization of graduate studies in the contemplated institutions;
4. To promote the mobility of faculty and students, with emphasis on doctoral students, postdoctors and faculty from abroad linked to *stricto sensu* graduate programs with international cooperation;
5. To encourage the transformation of participating institutions into an international environment;
6. To integrate other Capes development actions into the internationalization effort.



II. Goal

To attract talented young researchers from abroad, Brazilian or foreign, residing abroad, who have relevant academic-scientific experience abroad for teaching or research activities in themes and projects participating in the PII-Unifesp.

This support will be done by granting scholarships, with variable duration, according to the requests of the research projects participating in the IIP-Unifesp.

The execution of the activities at Unifesp aims to contribute to the advancement of strategic themes and Unifesp's institutional development.

III. Duration

The duration of the scholarship is in accordance with the requests of the projects as set out in Annex 1.

IV. Registration requirements and candidate assignments

1. To be a foreigner or Brazilian who has developed a research project abroad in the area of research that is part of IIP-Unifesp for at least 1 year;
2. To live abroad;
3. To have a doctor's degree and production indicators compatible with those required for permanent faculty accreditation at the Graduate Program to which they will be linked;
 - 3.1. The Graduate Program should be linked to the topic in which the research will be developed, as listed in Annex 1.
4. To have the ORCID registration that provides a unique identification related to the academic and research areas. Registration is free and can be done at <https://orcid.org/>.

V. Scholarship and financeable items

Monthly allowances, travel assistance, installation assistance and health insurance according to Capes Call N.41/2017 [Annex XI](#).



VI. Documents required for application

All documents below are required, and items (a), (b), (c), (e), (f) must be submitted in English. The documents should be sent to the coordinator of the theme, in PDF format, through the email informed in Annex 1.

a) Summary of the research project;

b) Research project to be developed during activities at Unifesp. The document must have a maximum of ten (10) pages of spacing 1,5, Times New Roman 12, with margins of 3.5 cm to the left and 1.5 cm to the right;

c) Justification of the importance of the activities in order to contemplate the 4 axes below:

1. Qualification of the academic indicators of the actors involved, as well as the performance of the Institution of origin, regarding: the infrastructure and research environment available for the project, indicators of excellence of the partners in the area and history of previous collaboration with UNIFESP researcher (publications, short-term sabbatical/internship programs, joint applications of grants);

2. To justify the relevance of the proposal submitted in terms of the appropriation of a new domain area and/or technology platform, so that the theme based in UNIFESP and the candidate's home institution obtains a qualitative leap in scientific production related to the thematic axis in question;

3. Attach to the proposal the planning of the activities scheduled to continue this collaboration, including joint application to international grant, mentioning the work schedule involved in this application. It is important that the candidate makes a written commitment to this dimension of the collaboration;

4. To define the expectation of academic gains for the collaboration/mobility to be financed, such as the inclusion of UNIFESP in international research networks, large-scale and potential multicentric projects, university consortia, activities that give international visibility to the



group, to Unifesp and to the foreign institution as well as publications in top 10 journals in the area, etc.

d) Curriculum Vitae updated, summarized;

e) Work schedule;

f) Acceptance Letter of Unifesp's faculty linked to a research project of the IIP-Unifesp.

VII. Obligations of the research fellow

It is the responsibility of the selected candidate

1. To check with the competent consulate the documentation and the requirements to obtain the appropriate visa and possible sanitary requirements.
2. To commit to the provisions of the Commitment Terms of the Capes Call N.41/2017 [Annex VII](#).

IX. Requirements of the institution abroad

The foreign institution of origin of the candidate should have excellence in the subject of the research.

X. Evaluation, selection process, appeal and result's homologation

The selection will be made in two steps:

The **first step** will be carried out based on the analysis of the documents requested in item VI, which will be sent electronically to the theme coordinator (contact in Annex I) who, together with the coordinators of the research projects participating in the theme, will evaluate the applications. The pre-selected applications will be forwarded by the theme coordinator to the Management Group, accompanied by a justification (up to 10 lines) of the importance of the project for institutional development.



The result of the **final selection** will be announced by Unifesp's Rectorate of Graduate Studies and Research through its website.

Unapproved candidates may appeal by sending a message to the theme coordinator within 3 days after the final result is released. The Management Group will respond to the appeal within 3 days from the date of receipt of the appeal sent by the themes' coordinator.

The Management Group will homologate the result.
